## SEASONS OF LIFE #2 (Waiting Season)

- 1. Waiting is a Time of Preparation and Growth Isaiah 40:31, Psalms 27:14 "Those who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength." Isaiah 40:31 "Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!" Psalms 27:14
- **2. Waiting Grows Patience and Trust** Proverbs 3:5-6, Isaiah 55:9, Romans 8:25 "Trust God from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. Listen for God's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track." Proverbs 3:5–6
