- **2. SIMEON'S PATIENCE** "Waiting Without Wasting"
 Luke 2:25 "He was waiting for the consolation of Israel."
 Some of your greatest breakthroughs will require the longest waiting periods. When God delays, He is not denying He is developing.
- **3. SIMEON'S SENSITIVITY** "The Spirit Still Speaks"
 Luke 2:27 "Moved by the Spirit, he went into the temple courts..."
 If you want Spirit-led moments, you need a Spirit-surrendered lifestyle. Many miss divine appointments because they're spiritually distracted.
- **4. SIMEON'S PRAISE** "My Eyes Have Seen Your Salvation" Luke 2:28–32 True peace is not the absence of problems, but the presence of Jesus. You can face life and face death with peace when Christ is your certainty.
- **5. SIMEON'S PROPHECY** "This Child Will Change Everything" Luke 2:33–35 Following Jesus is costly, but the cost of ignoring Him is far greater.
